ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

PAPER DAY - GREEN BIN

(PICK UP ON WEDNESDAY)

PAPER: (unsoiled)

- Clean scrap paper
- Junk mail without plastic window
- Newspapers, magazines, penny savers
- Shredded paper (in clear plastic bag)
- White paper

Please tie into bundles no more than 12 inches high.

CARDBOARD: (unwaxed)

- Corrugated shipping and packing boxes
- Shipping boxes (Amazon, UPS)

Please flatten and tie into bundles no longer than 4 feet.

RECYCLING - BLUE BIN

(PICK UP ON YOUR DESIGNATED DAY)

BOTTLES/CANS/PLASTICS:

- Aluminum foil (unsoiled)
- Aluminum pans (unsoiled, disposable)
- Beverage cans (beer, soda)
- Beverage glass bottles (beer, juice, liquor, wine)
- Food cans (tuna, vegetable)
- Food containers (plastics #1 & 2)
- Food glass jars (baby, pickles)
- Plastic beverage containers (plastics #1 & 2 – Gatorade, water bottles with no caps)
- Shampoo and detergent bottles

Rinse plastic, glass and metal recyclables clean. Please put into your blue recycling bin, and place at the curb on the days indicated as your designated recycling day.

S.T.O.P. PROGRAM

The Town of Hempstead's Stop Throwing Out Pollutants program holds hazardous waste collections from 8A.M. to 3P.M. once a month in various locations in the Town. Village of Rockville Centre residents may utilize this service by bringing hazardous or toxic household chemicals and products to the collection point for proper disposal at no charge.

ACCEPTED ITEMS: aerosol cans, ammonia, antifreeze, asbestos, batteries, bleach, chemistry sets, degreasers, disinfectants, drain cleaners, fertilizers, fire extinguishers, flammable liquids, fluorescent light bulbs, kerosene, lacquers, latex/oil-based paints, oven cleaners, paint strippers, paint thinners, paint brush cleaners, pesticides, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, propane tanks, solvents, spot removers, telephone books, thermostats, tires, varnish, waste oil, weed killers, wood polish.

NOT ACCEPTED: ammunition, commercial or medical waste, explosives, propane tanks over 20 pounds, radioactive or unlabeled materials.

ECYCLING PROGRAM

Please bring your electronics to 10 Sunrise Highway from 10 am to 2 pm on the first Saturday of every month.
