The Board reviewed the proposed agenda for the February 5, 2024, Board of Trustees meeting.

On motion of Trustee Conlon, duly seconded by Trustee Grillo and unanimously carried the Board adopted the following resolution to publish a legal notice for a public hearing regarding the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget.

RESOLVED, that the Village Administrator is authorized and directed to publish and post a legal notice for a public hearing to be held on March 18, 2024, at 7:00 pm, with respect to the adoption of the Village's budget for the fiscal year 2025, in the form and in the manner required by law.

On motion of Trustee Conlon, duly seconded by Deputy Mayor Baxley and unanimously carried, the Board adopted the following Resolution Rejecting Sealed Bids and Authorizing Readvertising Bid No. 2401DPW1(100) Purchase Ford F600 Rack Truck.

RESOLUTION REJECTING SEALED BIDS AND AUTHORIZING READVERTISING

Bid # 2401DPW1(1100) Purchase Ford F600 Rack Truck

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2024, pursuant to duly advertised specifications, the Village Purchasing Department publicly opened bids received in response to Bid # 2401DPW1(1100) Purchase Ford F600 Rack Truck for Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, upon reviewing the bids it became apparent that the specifications advertised by the Village included incorrect material information, in that the truck body that is needed to perform as a water truck will not work with the chassis specified in the bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department and the Public Works Department have recommended that all bids received in response to this bid advertisement be rejected, and that new bids be advertised with materially revised specifications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that all bids received on February 1, 2024, for Bid # 2401DPW1(1100) -Purchase Ford F600 Rack Truck are hereby rejected; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Department, with the assistance of the Public Works Department, is authorized to make any necessary revisions to the specifications for such bid, and to advertise them as provided by law, to be publicly opened and read at a date, time and place specified by the Purchasing Agent.

At 6:22pm, on motion by Mayor Murray, seconded by Deputy Mayor Baxley and adopted unanimously, the Board convened in executive session to discuss (a) legal advice, (b) matters leading to the hiring of a particular person or entity, and (c) pending litigation matters.

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the aforesaid legislation, the Village customarily holds its tax lien sale in May of each year;

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Real Property Tax Law section 1452(4), the Village of Rockville Centre will hold its sale of liens for unpaid tazes and other charges for tax year 2023 at the Village Hall on May 23,2024, at 10:00am, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Administrator and the Village Attorney shall cause notice of such sale to be given as required by law.

The Board discussed the proposed tentative budget. On motion of Mayor Murray, duly seconded by Trustee Grillo and unanimously carried, the Board adopted the 2025 Tentative General Fund Budget. The Board confirmed that the public hearing on the proposed 2025 budget would be held March 18, 2024.

On motion of Deputy Mayor Baxley, duly seconded by Trustee Shaughnessy and unanimously carried the Board adopted the following Resolution regarding the Community Development Block Grant $50^{\rm th}$ Program Year:

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development is authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to make grants to states and other units of general local government and to provide financial assistance to Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Rockville Centre has agreed to participate in the Nassau County Community Development Consortium for the 2024-2025 Program Year commencing on or about September 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Rockville Centre has developed certain Community Development project activities and funding allocations for said activities after holding Community Development Citizens Advisory Committee Meetings, a Public Hearing; and providing public information statements and notices, all pursuant to HUD regulations.

On motion of Trustee Grillo, duly seconded by Deputy Mayor Baxley and unanimously carried, the Board adopted the following resolution amending the Village Fee Schedule for the Department of Public Works.

RESOLUTION AMENDING VILLAGE FEE SCHEDULE - PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Whereas, the Village Public Works Department has advised that due to increased costs of providing solid waste pickup and disposal services to commercial and tax-exempt properties, and in order to avoid placing the burden of such expenses on other taxpayers, it is necessary to increase the charges to certain commercial and tax-exempt properties for sanitation pickup and disposal; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees has reviewed the recommendation of the Public Works Department for such increases, and finds and determines that such increases are reasonable as recommended by that Department;

Now, therefore, it is

RESOLVED, effective June 1, 2024, the portion of the Village Sanitation Fee Schedule (DPW) as set forth in the Village Code Fee Schedule for tonnage fees for commercial and tax-exempt establishments is hereby amended, to read as follows:

"SANITATION FEES (DPW)

Type

"Commercial Establishments producing in Excess of 250 lbs. of Garbage per week /per ton (in excess of the first 250 lbs. per week) \$92.50 and 75% Operations Fee

Tax Exempt Establishments producing in Excess of 250 lbs. of Garbage per week /per ton (in excess of the first 250 lbs. per week) \$92.50 and 75% Operations Fee"

and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Administrator shall take such action as may be required to include the foregoing fees in the Village Fee schedule as filed, and as posted and/or online.

On motion of Trustee Grillo, duly seconded by Deputy Mayor Baxley and unanimously carried, the Board voted to reserve a page in the official minutes of the meeting in memory of Charley Krahm.
