WHEREAS, the Village Superintendent of Electric. the Village Purchasing Officer, and the Village Comptroller have reviewed this request, and have recommended approval, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

Whereas, All County has requested that the Village consider partial relief to All County from some of the contractual provisions, in order that All County may continue to provide towing services and exercise towing rights as provided in the Contract, and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees wishes to modify some of the contractual provisions regarding payments to the Village, which modification are deemed to be in the best interest of the Village,

Now, therefore, be it
