AWNING PERMITS

A "slip" permit is required in Rockville Centre when you are installing an awning on commercial property.

REQUISITES FOR PERMIT:

- Proper liability insurance certificate naming the Village of Rockville Centre as additional insured in the amount of \$1,000,000 and certificate holder.
- Check made payable to the Village of RVC See current fee schedule.

Note: the following are the guidelines governing awnings:

- 1. There are two types of awnings: fixed frame and retractable.
- 2. All awnings must be at least 7'6" above the sidewalk, as measured from the lowest part of the awning frame.
- 3. Retractable awnings may only have 6" maximum height lettering on their lower valance (See example (C)).
- 4. 24" maximum height lettering may be applied to the <u>front</u> of a fixed frame awning when all the permanent wall signage has been removed form the face of the building (See example (A)).
- 5. 6" maximum height lettering may be applied to the <u>front</u> and <u>side</u> valance of a fixed frame awning when permanent wall signage is maintained on the face of the building (See example (B)).
- 6. Projection of any awning may not exceed a distance beyond a point 2' back from the face of the curb. Under no circumstances may an awning project more than 5'.
- 7. New awnings may not project further than existing awnings on the same side of the block. Wherever possible, a unified design and character should be sought within the same grouping of stores.
- 8. Awnings may be illuminated. The applicant must receive approval with regard to method, from the Building Department.
- 9. Frames shall be constructed of galvanized metal or aluminum tubing, either round or square stock with a minimum cross-sectional dimension of ¾" and designed in accordance with generally accepted standards.
- 10. A maximum of <u>three colors</u>, including lettering, may be used. Iridescent, day-glo and shocking colors are not permitted.
- 11. Shiny plastic type materials are not permitted to be utilized.
- 12. Cloth type materials of soft classical tones are required and subject to review.
- 13. Samples of materials, style and colors are required for review prior to approval.
- 14. Awnings that pre-exist in non-conformity with these guidelines must be brought into conformity when canvas and/or framework is replaced.
- 15. Awnings installed without a permit or installed not in accordance with these guidelines are subject to removal.
- 16. The Building Department must be notified within 24 hours of the installation so that a final inspection can be made.
- 17. Styles of Awnings are subject to approval by the Superintendent of Buildings.
