

Village of Rockville Centre Receives AAA Rating From S&P Global Rating

Rockville Centre, NY: Mayor Francis X. Murray is pleased to announce that the Village of Rockville Centre has received the highest possible bond rating from one of the top credit rating services. Standard & Poor's (S&P) Global Ratings has affirmed Rockville Centre's AAA rating for public improvements bonds. The exemplary rating means that the Village can secure a lower interest rate on bonds, reducing the cost to taxpayers. The agency also assigned its 'SP-1+' rating to the Village's bond anticipation notes. This is the highest rating S&P issues for short-term notes.

"I am extremely proud of the Village's S&P rating," commented Mayor Francis X. Murray. "My administration has worked diligently to bring about fiscal discipline to the operation of our Village while not impacting services. As S&P noted, conservative budget practices have enabled us to build a track record of positive financial results. The S&P report went on to say that the rating reflects its assessment on multiple factors for the Village including good financial management policies and practices and strong institutional framework, as well as recurring surpluses and very strong reserves.

"We are pleased that S&P recognized the importance of our strong financial practices that have been verified as effective even during the Covid-19 pandemic."
