

Overview of Pre-K 4's Summer Nursery Program

This program is designed to help children explore their own ideas at the same time they are gaining new skills. "Summer Nursery" will include numerous physical activities to encourage large muscle development in the playground. In art, a variety of media will be used and music and movement games are offered to develop coordination and rhythm. Stories, word games and creative drama offer opportunities for verbal expression. Through directed play in the program, the child develops socially and his or her capacity for adjustment to the formal experience of Kindergarten is enhanced. Academics from the school year are reinforced and continued through play and games. There will be many outdoor activities including sprinkler parties and picnics in our newly renovated playground and sprinkler park.

Each classroom has the most current state of the art early learning materials and is fully air conditioned. We are a pre-school education facility serving Rockville Centre and surrounding communities.

We offer two classes for **Pre K 4's** (age 4 before 12/31/18). One class will meet 5 mornings each week and the second class will meet 4 mornings each week. Parents choose to register their child **for one class**. Each class has a registration minimum and maximum. If enrollment is not sufficient for both classes, they will be combined into one 4-day-a-week class.

Child must have completed at least one year of Nursery School to enroll in this program.

Our Nursery School Program is staffed by certified teachers along with trained support staff.

Birthdate 1/1/14 to 12/31/14

Child must have participated in a nursery school program (at least 3 days a week) prior to registering for RVC Rec.

Department Summer Nursery Program.

Registration for residents begins on March 26, 2018 and will continue during office hours Monday through Friday 9:00am-7:00pm as long as openings prevail. Non Resident Registration will begin on Monday, April 9. All registration will take place at the Recreation Office. If this is your child's first pre-school experience with us, you must present a birth certificate, baptismal certificate or other proof of age, plus a copy of the most recent immunization record.
