Boxes:

- Consolidated Cardboard
- Cereal and cracker boxes
- Shoe boxes, gift boxes and electronics boxes
- Toothpaste, medication and other toiletry boxes
- Junk mail

Plastic

(Put out on your designated recycling day)

Bottles & jugs:

- Water, soda and juice bottles
- Milk and juice jugs
- Ketchup and salad dressing bottles
- Dishwashing liquid bottles and detergent jugs
- Shampoo, soap and lotion bottles

Cups and containers

- Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups
- Disposable cups and bowls
- Margarine, cottage cheese and other containers
- Produce, deli and take out containers

Metal/Glass

- Food and beverage cans, bottles, and jars

Unacceptable Items



- Batteries
- Blow up pools
- Chemicals (dry or liquid)
- Clothing or rags
- Concrete
- Dishes or ceramics
- Electric cords

- Flammable lights

S.T.O.P (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) Collections

The Town of Hempstead's Stop Throwing Out Pollutants program holds hazardous waste collections from 8A.M. to 3P.M. once a month in various locations in the Town. Village of Rockville Centre residents may utilize this service by bringing hazardous or toxic household chemicals and products to the collection point for proper disposal at no charge.



Items **ACCEPTED** by the program: paints, solvents, varnish, waste oil, antifreeze, batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, car tires (off the rim), and photography and pool chemicals.

Items **NOT** accepted by the program: commercial or medical waste, ammunition, explosives, propane tanks *over* 20 pounds, or unlabeled materials.
