Daily Activities

Daily activities include athletics, games, activities and arts & crafts. There are special events every week such as tournaments, dress-up days, scavenger hunts, mascot races and alligator pit competitions. Each group is led by trained recreation staff members plus our Leader-In-Training volunteers. Each group will have a group name and theme.

Afternoon Field Trip Information

Afternoon trips are offered as an additional option for each day of the program. A detailed flyer with dates, times and fees will be available online and at each site. A parental permission slip must be submitted with the fee attached for each trip. Only participants of the Summer Playground program are eligible. Anticipated trips this year are: Adventureland, Chocolate Works, LI Laser Bounce, RVC Lanes, Bounce-U, Merrick Movie Theatre, Bounce! Trampoline, and more.

Family Fun Fest and Summer Send-off Finale

Two highlights of Summer Playground are the Family Night Fun Fest and Summer Send Off. The Family Fun Fest, on **Wednesday**, **July 18**, includes a fantastic DJ leading us in dancing fun and games, a photo booth, crafts, face-painting and games of chance. Kids can win prizes donated by local merchants at the Chinese Auction. The Summer Send-off finale, on the last day of the program, features special games and activities including the Kona Ice truck, pizza lunch and talent show. The cost of this event is included in your registration fee.

What should my child bring (and not bring)?

Active attire, sneakers and sunscreen should be worn every day. Sprinkler Days are planned for Fridays (weather permitting), everyone should wear a bathing suit under their regular clothing and bring a towel. Please label everything your child brings or wears to camp. We will have snack time at approximately 10:25 every day. Send in a small snack in a bag or lunch box clearly marked with your child's name and group. We will be selling ice pops for 15 cents each or 2 for 25 cents. Children may not bring toys, cards or games to the program.

Cell phone and electronic device policy: Children who are registered and participating in the Summer Playground or Summer Rec. Program are prohibited from using cell phones and other electronic devices such as iPads, iPads, smart watches, etc. during program hours. The Summer programs offer a great opportunity to learn about and navigate social situations while not being constantly connected to and immersed within a digital/virtual world. If a child is involved in a video game or texting friends or parents, then they're not engaging in our wonderful array of activities. For those parents who simply want to keep in touch, we assure you that a supervisor will contact you or your designated emergency contact with any issues that may arise that require your attention. We encourage parents and children to talk about the day's activities at pick-up time. Similarly, cell phones represent a tether to one's parent and may serve as an impediment for a child to learn how to solve problems on their own in a structured and supportive environment.
