Section 1. Purpose and Legislative Intent

Pursuant to Chapter 97 of the Laws of 2011, the New York State Legislature has enacted a "tax levy limit" applicable to the Village budget. However, since the enactment of that law, it has become apparent that as a consequence of the severe limitations imposed by that legislation, the inability of the Village to obtain clear information from the government agencies charged with interpretation and enforcement of that legislation, the continuing demands imposed upon the Village budget by the State and other outside agencies, and the fiscal impacts of Superstorm Sandy, the Village may be required to exceed the levy limit for the next ensuing Village fiscal year, or might inadvertently exceed that limit without intending to do so. Furthermore, because the Village historically has maintained a fiscally prudent tax levy in past years, the tax levy limit imposed by the State legislation would permit only a minimal increase in the Village levy, which is likely to be insufficient to accommodate future mandated and necessary expenses. The consequences of exceeding the tax levy limit are severe for future Village budgets. Accordingly, as in past years, the Board of Trustees of the Village hereby determines that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents and taxpayers that the Village Board of Trustees have the discretion if needed to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2014-2015 which includes a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c, and particularly subdivision (5) thereof, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Rockville Centre is hereby authorized in its discretion, and should it determine the same to be necessary, to adopt a budget for the 2014-2015 fiscal year that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon adoption and filing pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law and shall be applicable only to the Village budget and real property tax levy for the Village fiscal year next commencing after such adoption.
