Section one. Findings. Existing Chapter 30 of the Code of the Village of Rockville Centre was enacted in 1971. The provisions of such chapter are inconsistent with later or other provisions of State law. The Board of Trustees hereby finds that it is desirable to enact amendments to Chapter 30 to conform to State law and to provide for procedures which the Board of Trustees determines are appropriate for the adoption of local laws by the Village Board of Trustees.

Section two. Chapter 30 of the Village Code is hereby REPEALED, and a new Chapter 30 is enacted, to read as follows:

“Chapter 30. LOCAL LAWS, ADOPTION OF.

§ 30-1. Notice and conduct of public hearings for adoption of local laws.

A. Pursuant to authority granted in the New York Municipal Home Rule Law, the provisions of New York Village Law § 7-706(1) are hereby superseded and amended in their application to

the Village of Rockville Centre.

B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, notice of public hearings for the adoption of local laws (other than zoning laws) shall be given by publication and posting at least three days prior to the date of commencement of such public hearing. Notice of public hearings for the adoption of zoning laws shall be given by publication and posting at least five days prior to the date of commencement of such public hearing.

C. Such notice by publication shall be given by the Village Clerk by causing the same to be published once in the official newspaper designated for such purpose, and in any other manner required by law. The Board of Trustees may designate one or more newspapers in place of or in addition to the official newspaper for publication of any such notice or notices. Notice by posting shall be given by posting at the Village Hall and in such other locations as may be customary, and at such locations otherwise required by law, and in any other manner designated by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees also may require other notice as it may deem appropriate in any particular case.

D. Notice of each such hearing, other than by publication or posting, also shall be given as required by any other applicable law.

D. Each such notice shall contain the title of the proposed local law. Such notice may also include any explanatory statement which the Village Clerk determines to be appropriate and which is in a form approved by the Village Attorney.

E. Proof of publication and posting of such notice of public hearing shall be filed in the office of the Village Clerk.

F. Village Law 7-706(5) is hereby amended and superseded in its application to the Village of Rockville Centre, and the following is enacted in its place and stead: '5. Filing. Every zoning law and every amendment thereto (excluding any map incorporated therein) shall be entered or incorporated by reference in the minutes of the Village Board of Trustees. The Village shall not be required to publish a copy, summary or abstract thereof, or any map incorporated therein, in the official newspaper, nor shall the Village be required to post a copy of such local law or amendment together with a summary or abstract of any map incorporated therein. Such minutes shall identify the adopted local law and any map adopted in connection with such local law or amendment.'"

Section three. This local law shall take effect immediately upon adoption and filing pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.

* Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.



5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20__ of the City of _____ having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on _____ 20__, became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20__ of the County of _____ State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____ 20__, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
